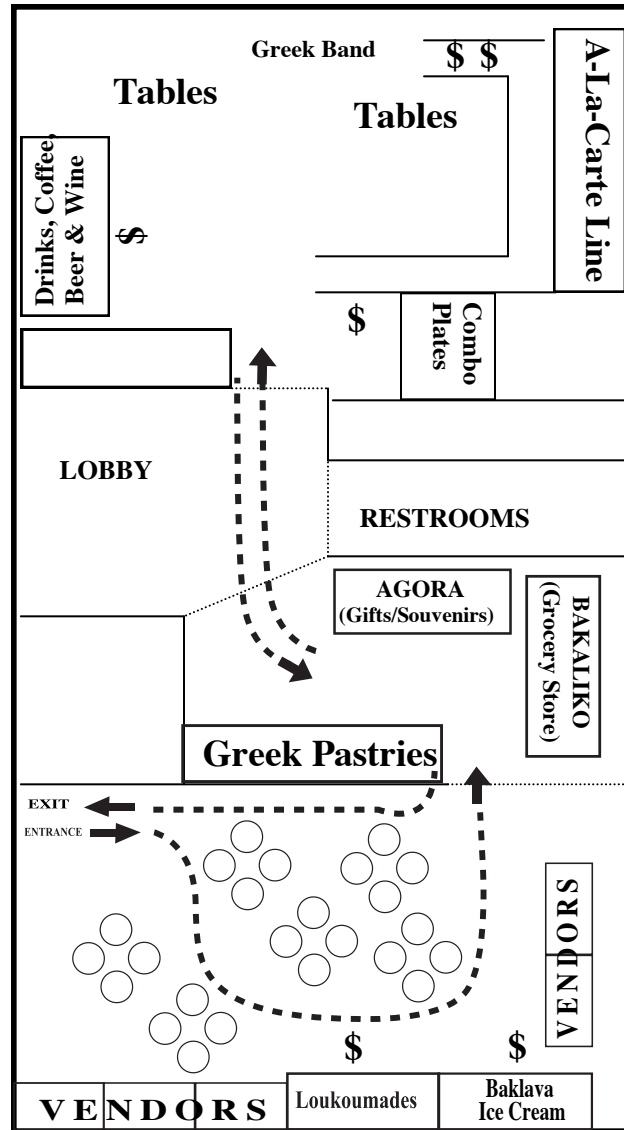

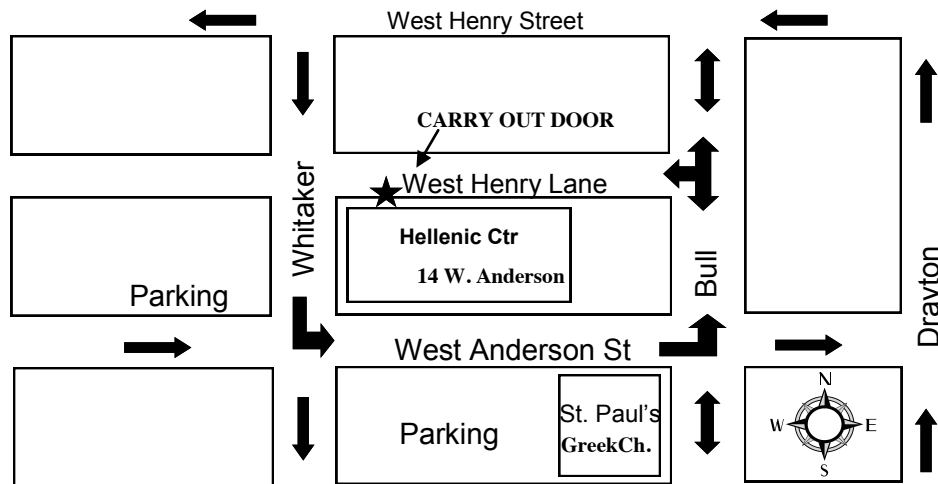

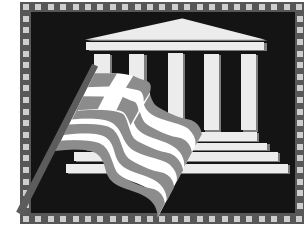
## "YIASOU"
